Each school board consists of 7 members. The board is a policy-making body responsible for the educational program for students from preschool through grade eight. The board adopts and monitors the school district budget, develops and approves district policies and hires the district superintendent.	none	none	Each school district maintains an extensive website, which includes information on the current board members.
2 C.O.D. District 502 Board Members	4 yrs. 2021-2025	part time	The College of DuPage Board of Trustees comprises seven publicly elected trustees and one non-voting student trustee.
